## Terminal No. 5 is added to the port of Baie-Comeau

**Baie-Comeau, November 26, 2020 – The Baie-Comeau Port Corporation announces the acquisition of a private port terminal at the port of Baie-Comeau. Previously owned by Resolute Forest Products, the facilities are now renamed Terminal No. 5.**

The new acquisition covers just over 25,000 square meters, including the wharf. Terminal No. 5 is now available to port customers for general cargo storage. Terminal guidelines and procedures are available on the Port Corporation [website](#).

*"Terminal No. 5 offers what customers have always needed at the port, namely, more accessible storage space,"* explains Karine Otis, General manager. Unused for several years, Terminal No. 5 is currently under a feasibility study to plan its future redevelopment. *"The purchase of the site and the completion of the study would not have been possible without the City of Baie-Comeau and Innovation et Développement Manicouagan financial support. We thank them for their confidence and support in the development of the port of Baie-Comeau "* add Marc Lefebvre, Chairman of the Board.

While the federal facilities transfer is being finalized, the Port Corporation does not stay idle; its website has been completely redesigned, and the work is ongoing for many other development projects. *"Our mission is to develop the port of Baie-Comeau full potential; therefore, we are undergoing several projects currently in development that will make the port an extraordinary tool for the local community and port's commercial clientele",* says Ms. Otis.

Remember that the federal port facilities transfer is scheduled for the year 2021. *"Until then, our priority is to put in place our standards and our operational procedures in order to be ready on the first day of the port's takeover",* concludes Ms. Otis.
